City of Brighton Water is temporarily reducing water
rates, extending the deadline for payment, and suspending
late fees through the month of June.
In addition to the rate reductions, the Brighton's Water
Assistance Program is designed for residential customers who
need temporary financial assistance to pay their water bill.
Residents who qualify may receive up to a \$300 credit on
